- **Developments** As explained at the recent LINK meeting, we are refurbishing our "back-of-house" facilities. So, in the main kitchen, we are putting in new ceilings, lights & extractor fans plus re-tiling walls & floor, replacing most of the equipment and installing a new walk-in freezer. Most of this work is under the expertise of our director, Mike Round-Turner. At the same time, we are roofing the staff kitchen & dining area and building a new store room next to the generator room. We are also refurbishing the residents' dining room with a view to making it acoustically sounder-better and this is being guided by another of our directors, Karen Baillie. There will new floors, ceilings, lights, tables and chairs. The room will have new floor to ceiling doors that will allow us to open the room up when we wish to and there will be a small expansion into the internal garden courtyard for those who prefer al fresco dining. Whilst all this is happening, Gladys will be operating out of a temporary kitchen on the rear parking area near the nurses' office and along side the temporary dining area for residents and staff. Residents' cars have been banished to the top parking lot on a temporary basis. Residents are requested to avoid the area and under no circumstances should they venture into the builder's work area please. We are expecting to have all the kitchen area back in production before the end of March. The dining room may take a bit longer but I will update you regularly.
